The Housing Executive is currently examining the demand for social housing in the village of Dunloy through a Rural Housing Need Test.



Social housing is good quality housing that is affordable and available to those in housing need. It is provided by both the Housing Executive and registered housing associations.



We are working with Clanmil Housing Association to determine if there is demand to provide further social rented homes at Mews Court, Station Road, Dunloy.

If you would like to be considered for Mews Court or for any available social housing in Dunloy, please come forward and register an interest with us. You will then have an opportunity to speak to one of our housing advisors about your housing requirements and if necessary, make an application. We will assess the level of housing need of each new applicant using our points system. Both the Housing Executive and Housing Associations allocate social housing based on need using the same waiting list for an area.
