The Housing Executive is currently examining the demand for social and affordable housing in the village of Ballyhalbert through its Rural Housing Need Test Programme.



Social housing is good quality housing that is affordable and available to those in housing need. It is provided by both the Housing Executive and registered housing associations.

Affordable or intermediate housing is aimed at those households who can afford a small mortgage but cannot afford to buy the property outright. Ownership will be shared with and part rented from a registered housing association (e.g. Co-Ownership HA).

The Housing Executive is responsible for identifying where there may be a shortage of social and affordable housing. We understand that those in need of a home may not always register on our waiting lists. Through a Rural Housing Need Tests we simply provide an opportunity for people in a particular area to come forward and speak to our housing advisors about their housing requirements and if necessary, make an application with us. We will assess the level of housing need of each new applicant using our points system. Both the Housing Executive and Housing Associations allocate social housing based on need using the same waiting list for an area.
