Summary Minute

Adults under 65 years with complex physical/health issues

The Department of Health (DoH) explained their statutory responsibility for adults with a physical and sensory disability and highlighted the difficulties, the lack of suitable accommodation has had on placements and discharge.

The SP Service Directory will be shared with DoH to assist in identifying suitable accommodation.

The number of SP funded accommodation based and floating support services for adults with a physical / sensory disability was shared.

There is ongoing work within the H&SCTs to identify need for adults under 65 with complex health issues.

Whilst the SP 3 Year Strategy sets out different options for long term accommodation we are currently operating in a very challenging environment.
