Waiting Lists and Points - Banbridge

1. Can you please advise what is the average points required before a transfer will be offered and the break down of recent transfers within the Banbridge area. Can you please provide an estimate of the waiting time tenants remain of the transfer list before they are rehoused?

Notes:

- The table above provides the number of allocations to transfers and the mean & median waiting time in months for a transfer to be allocated in the Banbridge Local Office area and at N. Ireland level. The table also includes the mean & median points at the point of allocation for the same geographical areas. The data is based over the period 01/10/2021 to 30/09/2022 and includes transfers to both Housing Executive and housing association properties.
- Mean & Median the MEAN is the arithmetic average and as a statistic can
 often be skewed by significant outliers i.e. applicants who have been on the
 waiting list for a much higher number of years than others. The effect of this is
 to push the average up and make it unrepresentative of the experience of
 most applicants. Therefore, following expert advice on this matter a
 methodology that utilises the MEDIAN (a measure of central tendency that is
 unaffected by outliers) in relation to Waiting Lists and Allocations is also
 provided.
