## **Discretionary Housing Payment Data**

1. The total number of households currently in receipt of Discretionary Housing Payments and (i) the total number of households who have been notified that their DHP has stopped due to budget pressures broken down per Council area.

At 31st of July 2023 there were a total of 10,525 claimants in receipt of Discretionary Housing Payment.

A total of 3,321 cases were ended however and a breakdown of these cases by Council Area is set out below.

I can advise that at 31st of July 2023 we have made 18,844 awards in the financial year beginning 1st of April 2023.
