- The quantity of each gender (singles) that has applied for housing and the quantity of each that has been rehoused.
- The figure spent on interpreter funding in the year 2024.

Clarification received 13 February

- The figures for 2024 and also the figures for the past 5 years.
- All of Northern Ireland
- The cost for telephone and face to face interpreting combined, disregarding sign language

Your request has been handled under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (FOIA).

In relation to question 4 of your request, the Housing Executive uses financial years for accounting and financial planning purposes. The amount spent on telephone and face-to-face interpreting (excluding Sign Language communication support) in the financial year 2023/2024 was £51,042.02.

Notes:

- Waiting List data is a snapshot of the social housing waiting list as it was on the last day of the specified quarter (31/12/2024).
- Allocations are aggregated over a 5-year period from 01/01/2020 to 31/12/2024 & over a 1-year period from 01/01/2024 to 31/12/2024 and include allocations to both Housing Executive and housing association properties.
- This response is based on the most recently published data (Waiting List data as at 31/12/2024 & Allocations data up to 31/12/2024).
- Nationality figures are based on the recorded nationality of the main applicant.
 Nationality and Ethnic Origin are as recorded in the Housing Management System.
- UK GDPR and Data Protection Act 2018 It is important to note the GDPR & Data Protection Act 2018 regarding the potential risk of identifying individuals and individual households. Guidance from NISRA suggests that equality monitoring information should not be disclosed in sensitive cases where individuals or individual households could be identified. Also, the Information Commissioner's Office (ICO) 'Anonymisation: Managing Data Protection Risk' Code of Practice states 'where less than 10 responses have been given to an answer that identifies something factual, all variables relating to that question have been suppressed'. However, 'it should be noted that attitudinal questions are not bound by this rule, in addition to responses of 'Don't know', 'Refused', 'Other' or similar'. As the information provided is considered sensitive, some statistical disclosure controls may have been placed on the tables with the omission of data in cases where there are less than ten Applicants.

- In relation to question 3 of your request, we have defined Single applicant household as a combination of Single Person Household and Elderly/Older Small Household Type, which includes:
 - o For Single Male applicants:
 - Single Male >16 and <18
 - Single Male 18 25
 - Single Male 26 59
 - Elderly/Older Male 60+
 - o For Single Female applicants:
 - Single Female >16 and <18
 - Single Female 18 25
 - Single Female 26 59
 - Elderly/Older Female 60+

Please note that due to system limitations, the categories Elderly/Older 60+ Male and Elderly/Older 60+ Female might not have been included in our responses to similar requests made before 01/03/2024.

• Household Composition/Type is recorded on our systems at the point of application and may not reflect the composition of the household at the snapshot date (31/12/2024).
