## Our response

1. I would like information on the number of females who have applied for housing on the grounds of leaving their home through domestic violence, and the same for male victims of domestic violence leaving their home due violence applying for housing.

As the Housing Executive has already provided data for the 2022/23 year under FOI\_160 a further expansion of the data has been provided below.

Within the period April 2020 to March 2022 a total of 2,171 households were accepted by the Housing Executive as homeless on the basis of Domestic abuse.

A gender breakdown of the head of household per year is provided in the table below.
