The HCS team gave an update on the four actions: <ul> <li>Recruitment: On hold until a decision is made about how to proceed with the next HCS;</li> <li>User engagement: The User Engagement Group met in October and an online user survey was carried out before Christmas;</li> <li>National Statistics: D McLarnon contacted the Office for Statistics Regulation (OSR). They confirmed they will be flexible in terms of the timing of a possible compliance check for the HCS. OSR will be notified when a decision is reached. They advised that users should also be updated on the decision as soon as possible;</li> <li>Sample design: Same update as <i>Recruitment</i>.</li> </ul> </li> </ul>	Research Unit DM/ Research Unit Research Unit

The paper includes an options appraisal on how to proceed with the next HCS. The purpose of the meeting is for the group to discuss the paper and put forward a recommended option.
