Housing Benefit claimants reporting shortfalls

Could NIHE detail what percentage of Housing Benefit claimants currently report a shortfall between their Housing Benefit entitlement for rent and the rent charged by their landlord as of 20th February 2023 for the following areas; Dunmurry, Ladybrook, Twinbrook, Lagmore, Poleglass and Stewartstown

To help assist I mainly talking about those individuals who only receive the local housing allowance which doesn't cover their full rent.

- (a) Within workgroup 201, 1682 of 2341 claimants (71.85%) have a shortfall between the rent charged by their landlord and the applicable Local Housing Allowance for the property occupied.
 - This workgroup relates to all of West and South Belfast, Poleglass and Twinbrook
- (b) Within workgroup 406, 528 cases of 656 (89.49%) have a shortfall between the rent charged by their landlord and the applicable Local Housing Allowance for the property occupied.

This workgroup relates to Dunmurry and Lisburn.

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
