## Information on homelessness and intimidation figures within the last five years.

1. How many cases have NIHE accepted in which people were presenting as homeless as a result of intimidation in the last five years, broken down by year.

## Response

The number of acceptances as statutorily homeless as a result of intimidation per Council area for the 5 year period 2017-22 are provided in the table below. It should be noted however, that in order to prevent identification of individuals, incidents below 5 have been anonymised.
