**FOI of NIHE Housing Data up to 31<sup>st</sup> March 2023**

- 1) As of March 31st, 2023, how many people remain waiting for temporary accommodation?**

*As part of its statutory duty, the Housing Executive will offer temporary accommodation to all who present as homeless and are found to be statutorily homeless. It does not, however, hold details of those who refuse offers of temporary accommodation in favour of making their own arrangements.*

- 2) How many properties has the Housing Executive secured for social housing tenants in the year ending March 31st, 2023? How many properties had been secured during the calendar year ending March 31, 2022 and also the calendar year ending March 31st, 2021? (defined as the sum total of how many properties have been acquired from private landlords and also built for each year who have been awarded to clients?)**

*The Housing Executive does not currently build properties nor does it purchase, or take over the management of, properties from private landlords.*

- 3) How many properties have been taken back by private landlords in the calendar year ending March 31st 2023? How does that compare to calendar years ending March 31st, 2022 and 2021?**

*The Housing Executive does not manage any privately owned properties.*

- 4) How many people were moved into permanent housing in the calendar year ending March 31st, 2023? How does this figure compare to the calendar years ending March 31st 2022 and 2021?**
