Our response

Please be advised that Waiting List and allocations data is produced quarterly, so the most recently available data is as at 31st March 2024.

The table below provides data on the number of housing allocations to applicants on the Waiting List in Belfast West, Belfast West/North and Belfast West/South Parliamentary Constituencies by Nationality, for a 6-year period from 01/04/2018 to 31/03/2024; the figures are based on the recorded nationality of applicants. The table should be viewed in conjunction with the accompanying notes.

 UK GDPR and Data Protection Act 2018 - It is important to note the GDPR & Data Protection Act 2018 regarding the potential risk of identifying individuals and individual households.
