## Our response

1) The table below shows the number of actionable\* and non-actionable\*\* void Housing Executive properties as of 1<sup>st</sup> December 2024, broken down by Area Office. Area Office boundaries are broadly coterminous with those of local councils.

\*Actionable voids are properties which are vacant while in the process of being allocated/awaiting change of tenancy repairs. These may also include properties deemed to be difficult to let.

\*\*Non-actionable voids are properties that are not immediately available for allocation and are held vacant for operational reasons i.e. decanting purposes (where they are being used to house a tenant on a temporary basis pending works to their home), planned maintenance schemes, and properties which have been identified for sale/transfer or have approval for demolition
